



SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS (Eng)

- 1 This show is open to all Gloster enthusiasts, every bird society member and any local or foreign gloster keeper or exhibitor.
- 2 No membership is necessary to take part in the Golden D-Cup.
- 3 Every exhibitor is obliged to fill in the registration form. The registration form also serves as an application to participate in the show. The applicant will be notified if he or she has been accepted via sms, Facebook messenger or by telephone.
- 4 If for any reason the organizers decide to decline a registration, the applicant will be notified via sms, Facebook messenger or by telephone without the need for any further explanation.
- 5 The exhibition cage shall be in line with the British standard of excellence as laid down by the GFCC-UK. Should any exhibitor wish to put an absorbent carton paper at the bottom of the cage, they can do so as long as the carton is covered with mixed canary seed. All cages will be closed with a cable tie during the show. Cages without a kidney shaped hole will not be accepted.
- 6 Every exhibit can be with or without closed ring. Split rings or Glosters with no ring are all accepted. This is an open show aimed at focusing on type and quality of the Gloster Fancy Canary.
- 7 There are 27 categories in the show which are derived from the British Gloster standard of excellence.
- 8 Bird registration fees are €10 plus €1.25 for every exhibit.
- 9 Only one exhibitor can be listed on every registration form.
- 10 Payments are accepted once the labels and cables ties are collected.
- 11 The organizers reserve the right to refuse exhibits during the bird entry to the show hall if the cage is not clean or the if bird is not in good health. (includes hygiene).
- 12 The only drinking recipient allowed in the show hall is the standard black D-Cup drinker. Should there be any doubt that a bird is not drinking the d-cup will be moved to the inside of the cage by one of the organisers.
- 13 No birds can be moved or removed from the show with no valid reason and without the permission of the organizers.
- 14 No birds other than participant show exhibits are allowed in the show hall.
- 15 The Show hall is a non smoking zone.
- 16 Every body is welcome to see the judging process as long as there is perfect silence.
- 17 The Judge's decision is final.
- 18 All through the exhibition the exhibitors are responsible for their birds.
The organizers are not liable for any damage of any sort of the birds, cages and other personal items in the show hall.
- 19 No one can collect thier birds until the show is officially closed.
- 20 The organizers reserve the right to take any decision under any circumstances not listed in the rules above.
The decision taken by the organizers is final.
